## Visit

- 1 **Chesterfield Museum**  
Explore the town's Roman origins.
- 2 **Bolsover Castle**  
A fairy-tale Stuart mansion with spectacular views over Derbyshire.
- 3 **Crich National Tramway Museum**  
Enjoy fascinating exhibitions, the woodland walk and sculpture trail.
- 4 **Hardwick Hall**  
One of the most splendid houses in England, built in the 1590's.

- 5 **Chesterfield Canal**  
A feat of engineering linking Chesterfield with West Stockwith.
- 6 **Fishing**  
Day permits for the country park can be purchased from reception if you have a rod licence.
- 7 **Creswell Crags**  
A limestone gorge with caves to explore and activities to enjoy, telling the story of life during the last Ice Age.
- 8 **Go Ape**  
The UK's No.1 forest adventure with tree walks, zip-wires and Tarzan swings.

## Walk

- 9 Trans Pennine Trail**  
This coast to coast route passes through the country park.
- 10 Peak District National Park**  
Outstanding walking, as well as some of England's finest climbing, cycling and caving is available in this spectacular National Park.



## Cycle

- 11 Poolsbrook Country Park**  
There are miles of cycle routes from the site through the adjacent country park. You can also cycle for miles on the Trans Pennine Trail which passes through the country park.

## Explore

- 12 Chesterfield**  
Historic market town with a range of shops, restaurants and attractions.
- 13 Bakewell**  
Idyllically situated on the River Wye, and famous for its pudding!
- 14 Matlock**  
The county town of Derbyshire, on the edge of the Peak District.



## Visitor's top tips

There's a lovely walk along the canal to Chesterfield, the market is not to be missed and make sure you see the church's famous twisted spire.

A walk around the lake is a must and if you have bikes, ride to Rother Valley Country Park.

Poolsbrook Park Run is just outside the gates. Really great friendly 5k most Saturday mornings at 9am.

Matlock Farm Park has a lovely petting zoo for toddlers.

The play park at Poolsbrook Country Park is fabulous for younger visitors and there is a cafe in the park.

Meadowhall shopping centre is good for a rainy day.

Idle Valley Nature Reserve just north of Retford has a great cafe for vegetarians and vegans, the veggie chilli and bean stews are delicious!

The site is great if you like to fish, there are three fishing lakes within 1/2 mile of the site.
